

Funny & Modern Wedding Ceremony Script

Opening Remarks: (Officiant stands before the couple and guests.)

Officiant:

“Welcome, everyone! We are gathered here today to witness and celebrate the union of [Partner 1] and [Partner 2]. Now, if anyone objects to this marriage... well, keep it to yourself because we didn’t come here for drama!”

(Guests chuckle.)

Ring Exchange:

Officiant:

(Partner 1 places the ring on Partner 2's finger, repeating after the officiant:)

“With this ring, I promise to always be your partner-in-crime, your Netflix binge buddy, and your greatest love.”

(Partner 2 does the same.)

Pronouncement: Officiant:

“By the power vested in me, and by the sheer joy radiating from this room, I now pronounce you married! [Partner 1], you may now kiss [Partner 2]... and make it a good one, the photos last forever!”

(Guests cheer and applaud.) Officiant:

“Ladies and gentlemen, for the first time ever, I present to you Mr. & Mrs./Mr. & Mr./Mrs. & Mrs. [Last Name]! Let's hear it for them!”

(Guests celebrate as the couple walks down the aisle as newlyweds.)
